Information for School and Youth Groups

School and youth groups are welcome and encouraged to use the park! However, parking is limited, particularly for buses. Therefore, we kindly ask that adult leaders notify the Park Ranger in advance of their visit so he can deconflict multiple groups trying to visit at the same time. Please send the following to john@villageofflatrock.org:

1. Date and time of visit
2. Number of children and adults (a minimum of 1 adult per 15 children is recommended)
3. Number and type of vehicles

The Staton Pavilion has eight, large picnic tables and is available on a first come, first serve basis unless it has been reserved. If you wish to reserve it, information and an application is available on the Village of Flat Rock website (villageofflatrock.org).

If you wish to use the park for a formal event such as a cross country meet or walk-a-thon, please submit a park use application at Village Hall. Information and an application are available on the Village website.

Guidelines

- If you are using the park or any park facility for an event, please be sure that all adult leaders are aware of the park rules posted on the bulletin board.
- All trash must be placed in trash barrels. If your event will be generating excess trash, please bring extra trash bags with you. Any trash bags containing food should be placed in the wooden dumpster corral near the pavilion. Trash food can attract animals and create a mess. All other trash bags can be placed near a trash barrel at the corner of the pavilion.
- **Parking along Highland Golf Drive is prohibited. This is a private street and not part of the park. Any unauthorized vehicles parked on Highland Golf Drive may be towed at the owner's expense.**
- **Alcohol, tobacco, grills, open fires and amplified noise are not allowed.**
