Agenda

A draft agenda for the January 14, 2021, council meeting was presented, and the following items were added: Under *Old Business – Item #7 – Board Term Limits*, and Under *New Business – Item #8 – Appointments to the Park Commission, Item #9 – Appointment to the Board of Adjustment*. With no further changes, Mayor Weedman stated an agenda had been set.

Mayor Weedman reviewed and revised the Mayor and Council Member Oversight Responsibilities

Council Member Dethero mentioned he is working on obtaining more information on the progress of the sewer line of Halfway Tree Mobile Home Park. He will be meeting with the sewer committee January 25, 2021.

Vice Mayor Coletta reported we are operating under the Governor’s Executive Order until January 8, 2021. The Governor is extending the protection of eviction until January 31, 2021.

The Henderson County COVID-19 cases have increased significantly, with no increase in deaths. Henderson County is in the red on the alert map.

Mayor Weedman and Vice Mayor Coletta have been working with NCDOT on the right-of-way acquisition figure, working on getting updated numbers and estimates to bring to Council later.

Council Member Gooch mentioned a financial report of the Flat Rock Park & Recreation Foundation will be given at the January 14, 2021 council meeting.

Administrator Christie welcomed the new council members and if anyone had any questions, don't hesitate to contact the office.

Park Ranger Wilkerson mentioned Trace and Company started working on the storm trail damage this morning.
