Mayor Staton presided over the February 4, 2019, agenda meeting at 9:30 a.m. Those present in addition to Mayor Staton were Vice Mayor Weedman, Council Members Brown, Gooch, and Posey, Village Clerk Parker and Village Administrator Christie. Council Members Dockendorf and Jamerson were not present.

Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Staton led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A draft agenda for the February 14, 2019, council meeting was presented. Council Member Gooch made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Vice Mayor Weedman. The vote was unanimous, motion carried.

Discussions

Council Member Brown mentioned the sign located on the west side of Greenville Highway at its intersection with North Highland Lake Road, which sign was damaged by a falling tree limb during a recent ice storm. She will obtain a cost estimate for the sign's replacement.

Vice Mayor Weedman mentioned he would not be in attendance at the February 14, 2019 council meeting. In his absence, Council will need to direct the tax collector to advertise delinquent tax accounts.

Vice Mayor Weedman reported that, as of January 31, 2019, the current fiscal year tax collections are at 98.6%, with \$935,434.00 total collected (see attached report dated January 31, 2019).

With no further discussions, Vice Mayor Weedman made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Council Member Posey. The meeting adjourned at 9:37 a.m.
